The Red Bull Division led several brigades during its tour, including air defense artillery, field artillery, engineers, armor and aviation. Spread-out to locations in nearly 20 countries, the brigades amassed to more

than 9,000 service members to support Task Force Spartan in providing capabilities such as aviation, logistics, force protection and information management.

Throughout the deployment, support from families, employers and communities back home never wavered, and the 34th Red Bull Infantry Division successfully accomplished the Task Force Spartan mission. The 34th Red Bull Infantry Division will hold its official Welcome Home Ceremony on August 27th, at the Minnesota State Fair Grounds.


